Provides funds to match a grant from the 34 Economic Development Administration for a defense diversification project at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard, including an 36 evaluation of the assets of the shipyard and the development of materials that promote 38 the assets of the shipyard and the Town of

#### **SUMMARY**

This bill appropriates matching funds to provide for an 46 evaluation of the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard to determine the utility of the facilities and technologies available at the 48 shipyard for private use by sector industries nondefense-related projects. The evaluation would be conducted

- by the Southern Maine Economic Development District in coordination with the Department of Economic and Community Development, the Economic Development Administration, and the Town of Kittery, among others. At the completion of the

- 6 plan to advertise the assets available at the shippard and in the Town of Kittery.
