'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment increases the General Fund cost of the bill by \$24,719 and \$100,428 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively. As amended, the bill includes General Fund appropriations totaling \$24,719 and \$315,222 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, for the Department of Corrections to provide additional educational funding for the Southern Maine Juvenile Facility.

The Governor's proposed supplemental budget, LD 2510, includes \$24,719 and \$100,428 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, for 2 part-time Teacher positions and one Teacher Aide position at this facility.

SUMMARY

This amendment maintains the same funding contained in the committee amendment but also provides funding for 2 part-time teacher positions and one teacher aide position due to a loss of federal funding. It also adds an emergency preamble and an emergency clause to the amendment.
