

This amendment also adds Other Special Revenue funds allocations of \$564,810 from the Fund for a Healthy Maine and \$252,085 from the Trust Fund for a Healthy Maine in fiscal year 2000-01.

As amended, this bill provides Other Special Revenue funds allocations of \$564,810 from the Fund for a Healthy Maine, \$252,085 from the Trust Fund for a Healthy Maine and a Federal Expenditures Fund allocation of \$19,810 in fiscal year 2000-01.

### **SUMMARY**

This amendment strikes the appropriation section and replaces it with an allocation section that allocates funds from Other Special Revenue funds to provide funds from the Trust Fund for a Healthy Maine for one Assistant Attorney General position and related costs. The amendment also allocates funds from Other Special Revenue funds to provide for one-time funds from the Trust Fund for a Healthy Maine to support litigation costs associated with the Maine Prescription Drug Fair Pricing Act. The amendment also makes the funds for the Assistant Attorney General position and the funds to support litigation costs associated with the Maine Prescription Drug Fair Pricing Act contingent upon the allocation of funds to the Trust Fund for a Healthy Maine.
