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30	Sec. C-1. Commission established. The Commission to Study Tax Credits for Prescription Drugs, referred to in this Part as the

- 7. One representative from the Bureau of Revenue Services within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, appointed by the Governor.
- Sec. C-3. Chairs. The first named Senate member is the Senate chair of the commission and the first named House of Representatives member is the House chair of the commission.
 - Sec. C-4. Appointments; meetings. All appointments must be made no later than 30 days following the effective date of this Part. The Executive Director of the Legislative Council must be notified by all appointing authorities once the selections have been made. When the appointment of all members has been completed, the chairs of the commission shall call and convene the first meeting of the commission no later than June 15, 2000.
 - Sec. C-5. Duties. The commission shall study the implications of and feasibility of establishing a state tax credit for prescription drugs.
 - Sec. C-6. Staff assistance. Upon approval of the Legislative Council, the Office of Policy and Legal Analysis shall provide necessary staffing services to the commission.
 - Sec. C-7. Compensation. The members of the commission who are Legislators are entitled to the legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2, and reimbursement for necessary expenses incurred for their attendance at authorized meetings of the commission. Other members of the commission who are not otherwise compensated by their employers or other entities that they represent are entitled to receive reimbursement of necessary expenses incurred for their attendance at authorized meetings.
 - Sec. C-8. Report. The commission shall submit its report, together with any necessary implementing legislation, to the First Regular Session of the 120th Legislature no later than December 31, 2000. If the commission requires a limited extension of time to conclude its work, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension.

Sec. C-9. Budget. The chairs of the commission, with
assistance from the commission staff, shall administer the
commission's budget. Within 10 days after its first meeting, the
commission shall present a work plan and proposed budget to the
Legislative Council for approval. The commission may not incu:
expenses that would result in the commission's exceeding its
approved budget. Upon request from the commission, the Executive
Director of the Legislative Council shall promptly provide the
commission chairs and staff with a status report on the
commission's budget, expenditures incurred and paid and available
funds.

Sec. C-10. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.
