shall cease to constitute a portion of Indian territory and shall revert to its their status prior to the inclusion thereof within
Indian territory.

FISCAL NOTE

36 This amendment requires the county commissioners to hold a referendum prior to land being added to either Passamaquoddy Indian territory or Penobscot Indian territory within 38 an unorganzied township of 100 or more residents. The additional 40 costs that will be incurred by the county commissioners are fully reimbursed through payments from the Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund as a qualifying expenditure within 42 the municipal cost components. The additional costs that will be 44 incurred by the counties, if any referenda are conducted, are expected to be minor.

SUMMARY

4 This amendment requires, prior to transfer of any land in an unorganized township of at least 100 residents to the 6 Passamaquoddy Tribe or the Penobscot Nation, approval of the residents of that unorganized township and of the State. The 8 country commissioners are required to hold the referendum.
