Sec. 1. Maine Governmental Facilities Authority authorized to issue additional securities to replace the Lewiston District Court. Resolved: That, pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 4, section 1606, subsection 2, the Maine Governmental Facilities Authority is authorized to issue additional securities in its own name in an amount of \$2,000,000 for the purpose of replacement of the Lewiston District Court.

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10 SUMMARY

This resolve authorizes the Maine Governmental Facilities Authority to issue additional securities in the amount of \$2,000,000 to replace the Lewiston District Court. This authorization is in addition to the \$5,000,000 previously approved. The additional authority is needed to meet increased construction costs and to provide an expansion in the size of the facility.
