This amendment prohibits expenditure of the appropriated in the bill unless matching funds are received from the federal Economic Development Administration. If matching funds are not received, the funds appropriated in the bill revert General Fund. The amendment also changes appropriation to funnel the funds through the Department of Economic and Community Development. The Southern Maine Economic Development District is required to submit a plan for the use of the funds to the department, which has approval and oversight authority.
