32 **FISCAL NOTE**

34 The Department of Corrections will require annual General  
36 Fund appropriations of approximately \$18,000 beginning in fiscal  
38 year 2001-02 to support the estimated cost of the dues associated  
40 with the Interstate Compact for Adult Offenders Supervision.

The additional costs associated with the compact can be  
absorbed by the Judicial Department and the Department of the  
Attorney General utilizing existing budgeted resources.'
