Resolved: That the Director of the Emergency Services Communication Bureau within the Department of Public Safety shall develop and begin implementing no later than August 1, 2000 a specific, organized and detailed plan for assessing, understanding, addressing and improving the bureau's relationship and communications with providers of emergency services and dispatching services and with community leaders and the public; and be it further

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Sec. 3. Report. Resolved: That the Director of the Emergency Services Communication Bureau within the Department of Public Safety shall submit to the Joint Standing Committee on Utilities and Energy no later than August 1, 2000 the plans it is required to develop pursuant to this resolve.

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

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FISCAL NOTE

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The Department of Public Safety will incur some minor additional costs to implement several planning efforts and to submit a required report to the Legislature. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment replaces the bill and converts the bill into a resolve. The resolve requires the Director of the Emergency Services Communication Bureau within the Department of Public Safety to:

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- Develop and implement a plan for monitoring, evaluating and making appropriate adjustments to the E-9-1-1 system as it is implemented and operated;
- 2. Develop and implement a plan for improving the bureau's relationship and communications with providers of emergency services and dispatching services and with community leaders and the public; and
