COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1888, L.D. 2628, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Chapter 6: Certification of Law Enforcement Officers, a Major Substantive Rule of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy"

Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Disapproval. Resolved: That final adoption of Chapter 6: Certification of Law Enforcement Officers, a provisionally adopted major substantive rule of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy, that has been submitted to the Legislature for review pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A is not authorized.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the resolve. The amendment specifies that final adoption of Chapter 6: Certification of Law Enforcement Officers, a provisionally adopted major substantive rule of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy regarding part-time law enforcement officers, is not authorized.
