46	Waters Fund to be submitted to the joint standing committee having jurisdiction over matters pertaining to state parks and
48	public lands. It also provides for the Land for Maine's Future Board to be reviewed under the State Government Evaluation Act by
50	the joint standing committee having jurisdiction over matters pertaining to state parks and public lands.
