SENATE AMENDMENT A " to H.P. 1892, L.D. 2633, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry Relating to Review of the Maine Seed Potato Board Under the State Government Evaluation Act"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Appropriates one-time funds for equipment, capital improvements and repairs at the Porter Nuclear Seed Facility. Funds appropriated for this purpose may not lapse but must be carried forward into the next fiscal year to be used for the same purpose.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$49,000 in fiscal year 2000-01. As amended, this bill includes a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$100,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources for equipment, capital improvements and repairs at the Porter Nuclear Seed Facility.

This amendment reduces the appropriation and clarifies that the funding is on a one-time basis.
