
**An Act to Fund the State's Share for Salt or Sand-salt Storage Facilities

2 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

4 **Whereas,** additional money is needed to help fund the
6 construction of priority one and priority 2 salt or sand-salt
storage facilities projects; and

8 **Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
10 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
12 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,

14 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

16 **Sec. 1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated
18 from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

22 **TRANSPORTATION, DEPARTMENT OF**

24 **Highway Maintenance**

26 Capital Expenditures \$1,820,000

28 Provides funds for the construction of salt
or sand-salt storage facilities within
30 priority one and priority 2 projects
established pursuant to the Maine Revised
32 Statutes, Title 38, section 411.

34 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

38 **SUMMARY**

40 This bill provides a one-time General Fund appropriation of
\$1,820,000 to the Department of Transportation for use in the
42 construction of salt or sand-salt storage facilities.
