An Act to Fund the State's Share for Salt or Sand-salt Storage Facilities Construction.

Presented by Representative BUMPS of China. Cosponsored by Representatives: RINES of Wiscasset, SAVAGE of Union, WESTON of Montville. Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, additional money is needed to help fund the 6 construction of priority one and priority 2 salt or sand-salt storage facilities projects; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

34 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

This bill provides a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$1,820,000 to the Department of Transportation for use in the construction of salt or sand-salt storage facilities.
