2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §956, sub-§2, ¶¶G, J and K, as enacted by PL
4	1995, c. 488, $\S$ 2, are amended to read:
6	G. Identification of those areas where an agency has coordinated its efforts with other <u>state and federal</u>
8	agencies in achieving program objectives and other areas in which an agency could establish cooperative arrangements,
10	including, but not limited to, cooperative arrangements to coordinate services and eliminate redundant requirements;
12	J. Identification of emerging issues for the agency or
14	program in the coming years; and
16	K. Any other information specifically requested by the committee of jurisdiction <del>.; and</del>
18	Sec. 2. 3 MRSA §956, sub-§2, ¶L is enacted to read:

22	L. A comparison of any related federal laws and regulations to the state laws governing the agency or program and the rules implemented by the agency or program.

26	FISCAL NOTE
20	Each department or agency subject to Government Evaluation
28	Act review will incur some minor additional costs to provide additional information as part of its report under the Act.
30	These costs can be absorbed within the affected departments' and
32	agencies' existing budgeted resources.
34	SUMMARY
36	This bill implements a recommendation of the Task Force to
38	Study the Effect of Government Regulation on Small Businesses. It adds a requirement that each agency or program under a State
50	Government Evaluation Act review:
