HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1922, L.D. 2668, Bill, "An Act to Create a Heating Oil Emergency Management Program"

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "S4994." by striking out all of subsection 3.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the language that directs the Governor to submit emergency legislation to appropriate the needed funding for a heating oil emergency management program and to work with the Maine Congressional Delegation and the governors of the northeastern states to petition the Federal Government to release sufficient funds to meet the anticipated needs of the program.
