HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1924, L.D. 2670, Bill, "An Act Regarding Lifetime Hunting and Fishing Licenses"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 3.

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

2000-01

REVENUES

Other Funds \$55,250

The establishment of certain lifetime hunting and fishing licenses will increase Other Special Revenue funds collected by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife by \$55,250 in fiscal year 2000-01. The estimated future increase is \$110,500 for each of fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03.

The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will incur some minor additional costs to submit a required report to the Legislature. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'
