HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1925, L.D. 2671, Bill, "An Act to Implement Municipal Recommendations Regarding Surface Water Use on Great Ponds"

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause and before section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §685-C, sub-§10, ¶D, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 739, §1, is amended to read:

D. Great ponds with less than all but more than 2/3 of their surface area in or partly in the jurisdiction of the commission that are identified as being of statewide significance in the "Maine Wildlands Lake Assessment" dated June 1, 1987 prepared by the commission, with 2 or more outstanding resource values in fisheries, wildlife, scenic or shore character and with more than 1/2 of their shoreline in public and private conservation ownership with guaranteed public access for low-impact public recreation, except that personal watercraft may be operated on Passamagamet Lake, Passamagamet Falls and Ambajejus Falls in T1R8 and T1R9 in Piscataquis County.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.


