SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1927, L.D. 2673, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Commission to Propose an Alternative Process for Forensic Examinations for Sexual Assault Victims"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 10 and 11.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment strikes the \$2,400 General Fund appropriation and the \$3,600 Highway Fund allocation in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Bureau of State Police within the Department of Public Safety associated with the costs of providing forensic examination kits to all licensed hospitals and licensed health care practitioners. The Department of Public Safety will have to absorb these costs within existing budgeted resources.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the appropriation from the General Fund and the allocation from the Highway Fund to the Bureau of State Police that provides funding for the costs of providing forensic examination kits to hospitals and health care practitioners.
