SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 771, "Joint Study Order to Establish the Commission to Study Single-sales Factor Apportionment"

Amend the joint order in subsection 7 by inserting at the end the following: 'Public members not otherwise compensated by their employers or other entities whom they represent are entitled to receive reimbursement of necessary expenses for their attendance at authorized meetings of the commission.'

Further amend the joint order in subsection 8 in the 2nd line by striking out the following: "January 1, 2000" and inserting in its place the following: 'December 1, 1999'

Further amend the joint order in subsection 8 by inserting at the end the following: 'If the commission requires a limited extension of time to conclude its study and make its report, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension.'

SUMMARY

The amendment changes the reporting date to December 1, 1999 and authorizes the Legislative Council to extend the deadline. It also provides for compensation of public members of the commission who are not otherwise compensated.
