SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1730, "Joint Order, Directing the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs to Report out A Bill Regarding the Maine Learning Technology Endowment"

Amend the order by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'ORDERED, the Senate concurring, that the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs report out, to the House, a bill, "An Act to Transfer \$3,500,000 from the Maine Learning Technology Endowment to the General Purpose Aid Cushion."

SUMMARY

This amendment orders the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs to report out the bill instead of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs.
