2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §682, sub-§4** is enacted to read:

6 **4. Exit polling prohibited.** A person may not conduct exit
8 polling within 250 feet of the voting place as well as within the
10 voting place itself.

12 **SUMMARY**

This bill prohibits exit polling within the voting place as well as within 250 feet of the voting place.
