Whereas,** Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, graduation will have passed by the time the 6 Legislature adjourns; and

8 Whereas, this legislation needs to be an emergency in order to allow diplomas to be awarded before the end of the current 10 school year; and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 16 safety; now, therefore,

18 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4722, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 859, Pt. C, §§5 and 7, is amended to read:

4. school student Exception. Α secondary who has satisfactorily completed the freshman year in an accredited 24 degree-granting institution of higher education may be eligible to receive a high school diploma from the school the student last 26 attended, although the student may not meet the graduation requirements of this Title. A veteran of World War II who was 28 honorably discharged may be eligible to receive a high school diploma from the school the veteran attended, although the 30 veteran may not have met the graduation requirements of this 32 Title.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

SUMMARY

40 This bill allows a local school board the option of granting a diploma to a veteran of World War II who was honorably 42 discharged even though the veteran does not meet the graduation requirements of this Title.
