SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 28, L.D. 28, "Resolve, to Extend the Commission to Study Equity in the Distribution of Gas Tax Revenues Attributable to Snowmobiles, All-terrain Vehicles and Watercraft"

Amend the resolve in the 7th paragraph after the title in 2nd line (page 1, line 34 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "6," and inserting in its place the following: '5,'

Further amend the resolve in section 3 in the last 2 lines (page 3, lines 1 and 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "any time after the effective date of this resolve" and inserting in its place the following: 'not later than August 15, 2001'

Further amend the resolve in section 5 in the 4th line (page 3, line 43 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "6," and inserting in its place the following: '5,'

Further amend the resolve in section 5 in the 5th line (page 3, line 44 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "an" and inserting in its place the following: 'a limited'

Further amend the resolve in section 6 in the last line (page 4, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "by the" the following: 'chairs of the'

Further amend the resolve in section 7 in the 7th line (page 4, line 15 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "are not" the following: 'otherwise'

This amendment accomplishes the following.

1. It changes the reporting date from December 6, 2001 to December 5, 2001.

2. It specifies that the first meeting must be convened no later than August 15, 2001.

3. It specifies that the extension of time for reporting that may be granted must be limited.

4. It specifies that it is the chairs of the commission, rather than the entire commission, who may request assistance from various state agencies and the Office of Fiscal and Program Review.
