Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §3915, as amended by PL 1997, c. 690, §12, is
4 further amended to read:

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§3915. Violation

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Any person who violates this chapter commits a civil
violation for which a forfeiture of not less than \$50 nor more
10 than ~~\$250~~ \$500 may be adjudged.

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SUMMARY

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This bill increases the limit of a fine for allowing a dog
16 to roam at large from \$250 to \$500.

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
