HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 33, L.D. 42

As amended, this bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$100,000 in fiscal year 2002-03 for the Treasurer of State,
Endowment Incentive Fund to match qualified private donations for academic purposes at Maine's public institutions of higher education.

8 Any additional costs associated with managing the investment of the matching funds and other administrative responsibilities 10 can be absorbed by the Maine Maritime Academy, the Maine Technical College System and the University of Maine System 12 utilizing existing budgeted resources.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the emergency preamble and emergency 18 clause and delays the funding provided to the Endowment Incentive Fund from fiscal year 2001-02 to fiscal year 2002-03. 20
