2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1973, sub-§4, ¶C** is enacted to read:

6 C. The authority may not charge a fee at the Exit 1 York
8 tollbooth on the Maine Turnpike for southbound traffic on
10 the Sunday preceding Labor Day and Labor Day.

14 This bill prohibits the Maine Turnpike Authority from collecting tolls at the Exit 1 York tollbooth on the Maine Turnpike for southbound traffic on the Sunday preceding Labor Day and Labor Day.
