22	Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting
24	the following:
26	'An Act to Allow Funeral Escort Vehicles in a Funeral Procession to be Equipped with Flashing Yellow Lights'
28	Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of
30	paragraph H and inserting in its place the following:
32	' <u>H. A vehicle in a funeral procession may be equipped with a flashing light. The light must emit a yellow beam of</u>
34	light. The light may not be more than 5 inches in diameter and must be placed on the dashboard. The light must be
36	shielded so that the emitted light does not interfere with the operator's vision. The flashing light may be used only
38	when the vehicle is used in a funeral procession.'
