COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 59, L.D. 68

SUMMARY

4 This amendment is the minority report. It strikes the title and language of the original bill. The amendment clarifies the 6 current prohibition on the sale of motor vehicles on Sunday by allowing licensed dealers of motorcycles, whose primary business 8 is the buying and selling of motorcycles, to display motorcycles on their lots on Sunday and to answer questions about features, 10 options and accessories on those displayed motorcycles. The bill does not, however, remove the prohibition against sales of motor 12 vehicles on Sunday.
