2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §3203-B** is enacted to read:

6 **§3203-B. Motorcycles**

8 A person who is licensed in accordance with Title 29-A,
10 chapter 9, subchapter III and whose primary business is the
12 buying and selling of motorcycles is exempt from section 3203 as
14 it relates to that person's primary business.

12 **SUMMARY**
