HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 60, L.D. 69, Bill, "An Act to Expand the Lifetime Hunting License"

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause and before the section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7161, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1999, c. 690, §1, is further amended to read:

1. **Infants and seniors.** The following resident lifetime licenses may be purchased:

A. For a resident who is less than 6 years of age:

(1) An infant resident lifetime fishing license. The fee for an infant resident lifetime fishing license is \$150;

(2) An infant resident lifetime hunting license. The fee for an infant resident lifetime hunting license is \$150; and

~~(2-A) An infant resident lifetime archery hunting license. The fee for an infant resident lifetime archery hunting license is \$150;~~

(3) An infant resident combination of any 2 lifetime ~~fishing and hunting license~~ licenses. The fee for an infant resident combination of any 2 lifetime ~~fishing and hunting license~~ licenses is \$250; and

42 the license in the year in which that person turns 66
years of age, \$78 for a person who purchases the
44 license in the year in which that person turns 67 years
of age, \$62 for a person who purchases the license in
46 the year in which that person turns 68 years of age and
\$46 for a person who purchases the license in the year
48 in which that person turns 69 years of age.

2 A person who is 70 years of age or older is entitled to
3 receive a complimentary lifetime license under section 7076,
4 subsection 1.'

6 Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any
7 nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read
8 consecutively.


