COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 61, L.D. 70, Bill, "An Act to Designate the Second Saturday in September as Youth Field Day"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Designate the Second Saturday in September as Maine Youth Field and Stream Day'

Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §140 is enacted to read:'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§139.~~" by striking out all of the first line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'§140. Maine Youth Field and Stream Day'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§139.~~" in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Youth Field Day" and inserting in its place the following: 'Maine Youth Field and Stream Day'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:
