Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7107-A, sub-§5, ¶F is enacted to read:

6 F. Notwithstanding section 7458, subsections 1 and 2, a
8 person who has taken a deer during the regular deer hunting
10 season may hunt for and kill a 2nd deer with a
12 muzzle-loading firearm during the special muzzle-loading
14 open season under subsection 4. The 2nd deer may be a buck
16 only.

SUMMARY

14 This bill allows a person who has killed a deer during the
16 regular deer hunting season to hunt and kill a 2nd deer with a
18 muzzle-loading firearm during the muzzle-loading hunting season
for deer. The 2nd deer may be a buck only.
