2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1483, sub-§14**, as amended by PL 1995, c. 12,  
§2 and affected by §4, is further amended to read:

6 **14. Antique and experimental aircraft.** Antique and  
experimental aircraft as defined in Title 6, section 3,  
8 subsections 10-A and 18-E and registered according to the  
provisions of Title 6; and

10 **Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §1483, sub-§15**, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 12,  
12 §3 and affected by §4, is amended to read:

14 **15. Adaptive equipment.** Adaptive equipment installed on a  
motor vehicle owned by a disabled person or the family of a  
16 disabled person to make that vehicle operable or accessible by a  
disabled person; and

18 **Sec. 3. 36 MRSA §1483, sub-§16** is enacted to read:

20 **16. Antique autos.** Antique autos as defined in Title 29-A,  
22 section 101, subsection 3 and registered according to the  
24 provisions of Title 29-A.

26 **SUMMARY**

28 This bill exempts antique autos from the excise tax.
