COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 80, L.D. 89, Bill, "An Act to Eliminate the Requirement That a Person Provide a Social Security Number for a Driver's License"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

Removing the requirement that the Secretary of State collect a person's social security number will result in the State being out of conformity with federal law that requires the collection and use of social security numbers for use in child support enforcement and will put the State's Child Support Enforcement Program's approved State Plan in jeopardy and, if disapproved, will result in the loss of approximately \$18,300,000 annually in federal funds to the Department of Human Services for the Child Support Enforcement Program and \$3,900,000 annually in federal funds for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program. The Department of Human Services will require additional General Fund appropriations to offset the loss of the federal funds associated with the operation of these programs. The timing of the appropriation will depend on the quarter in which the Federal Government deems the State Plan to be out of compliance.'
