## SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report and replaces the bill. The amendment clarifies the offense of using a handheld telephone while operating a motor vehicle. The amendment also specifies that law enforcement officers, corrections officers and firefighters; drivers of authorized emergency vehicles; holders of commercial driver's licenses; public transit personnel; and municipal public works personnel, Maine Turnpike Authority personnel and state transportation personnel, including all employees and contractors of the Department of Transportation, may use handheld telephones while driving within the scope of their employment. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
