**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7055, first ¶,** as amended by PL 1989, c. 493,  
4 §7, is further amended to read:

Sheriffs, deputy sheriffs, police officers, constables,  
8 marine patrol officers, Baxter Park rangers, wardens of the  
Penobscot Indian Nation within the Penobscot Indian Territory, as  
10 defined by Title 30, section 6205, subsection 2, wardens of the  
Passamaquoddy Tribe within the Passamaquoddy Indian Territory, as  
12 defined by Title 30, section 6205, subsection 1, and law  
enforcement personnel employed by the United States Department of  
the Interior shall have the powers of game wardens.
