COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 104, L.D. 108, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Taxation of Goods Purchased in Connection with the Operation of High-stakes Beano and High-stakes Bingo and Expanding the Number of Authorized Games"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Expand the Number of Authorized High-stakes Beano and High-stakes Bingo Games'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §314-A, sub-§9 is enacted to read:

9. Exception. Notwithstanding subsection 3, an organization licensed under this section may operate high-stakes beano or high-stakes bingo games on New Year's Eve and New Year's Day.'

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the section of the bill that states that the operation of high-stakes beano and high-stakes bingo is within a federally recognized Indian tribe's governmental capacity. It retains the provision that permits games to be conducted on New Year's Eve and New Year's Day.
