2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7457, sub-§4** is enacted to read:

6 **4. Taking additional deer.** The commissioner may permit a
8 person to hunt for and take a 2nd deer with a firearm during the
10 open season established in subsection 1 after that person has
12 taken a deer and paid an additional \$50 fee. The commissioner
14 shall specify the sex of this 2nd deer and the zone from which it
16 may be taken.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill allows the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and
18 Wildlife to permit a person to hunt for and take a 2nd deer with
20 a firearm during the open season on deer after that person has
taken a deer and paid an additional \$50 fee. The commissioner
shall specify the sex of this 2nd deer and the zone from which it
may be taken.
