Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7457, sub-§4 is enacted to read: 4 4. Taking additional deer. The commissioner may permit a person to hunt for and take a 2nd deer with a firearm during the 6 open season established in subsection 1 after that person has taken a deer and paid an additional \$50 fee. The commissioner 8 shall specify the sex of this 2nd deer and the zone from which it 10 may be taken. 12 SUMMARY 14 This bill allows the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and 16 Wildlife to permit a person to hunt for and take a 2nd deer with a firearm during the open season on deer after that person has taken a deer and paid an additional \$50 fee. The commissioner 18 shall specify the sex of this 2nd deer and the zone from which it 20 may be taken.
