COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 109, L.D. 113, Bill, "An Act to Remove the Weight Limit Restrictions on Vanity Registration Plates"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the last line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "7." the following: 'The Secretary of State may not issue vanity plates for vehicles registered pursuant to section 504, subsection 2, or section 512, 531 or 532.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

Removing the weight limit restrictions on vanity registration plates will increase annual Highway Fund revenue collected by the Department of the Secretary of State by \$18,000 beginning in fiscal year 2001-02.'
