2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6722, as amended by PL 1999, c. 94, §1, is

6	§6722. Closed areas
8	Unless modified by regulation adopted under section 6171-A, it is unlawful to fish for or take scallops in the coastal waters
10	from April 16th to November 30th, both days inclusive; except that, for persons fishing pursuant to a license issued under
12	section 6703, it is unlawful to fish for or take scallops in the coastal waters from April 16th to October 31st, both days
14	inclusive.
