**Sec. 1. Maine Turnpike Authority to create turnpike Exit 9 pass.**

2 **Resolved:** That the Maine Turnpike Authority shall develop and  
implement a plan to provide a waiver for travelers entering the  
4 turnpike from Exit 8 or Exit 10 and exiting at Exit 9. Travelers  
would pay the current user fee at Exit 8 and Exit 10 and upon  
6 request would receive a pass to use Exit 9 at no charge.

**SUMMARY**

This resolve directs the Maine Turnpike Authority to provide  
12 a waiver for travelers exiting at Exit 9 in Falmouth from Exit 8  
in Westbrook and Exit 10 in West Falmouth. Current user fees for  
14 Exit 8 and Exit 10 would not be affected.
