6 **CHAPTER 207-A**

8 **CONSIGNMENT SALES**

10 **§1257. Requirements for consignment sales**

12 A person who receives goods for sale on consignment shall
14 provide the following to the person who consigns these goods for
16 sale:

18 1. Itemized receipt. An itemized receipt of the goods
20 consigned for sale; and

22 2. Copies of receipts of sales of goods. Copies of the
24 receipts of the sales of the goods consigned for sale.

26 **SUMMARY**

28 This bill requires a person who receives goods for sale on
consignment to provide an itemized receipt of these goods and
copies of the receipts of the sales of these goods to the person
who consigns them.
