An Act to Revise the Hampden Water District Charter.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. P&SL 1937, c. 34, §8, 2nd ¶, last sentence, as enacted, is 4 repealed. Sec. 2. P&SL 1937, c. 34, §8, 3rd ¶, as amended by P&SL 1969, c. б 34, §§2 and 3, is repealed and the following enacted in its place: 8 As soon as convenient after the initial members of the board are chosen, the trustees shall hold a meeting at the town 10 councilor's office in the Town of Hampden, to be called by one of the trustees upon reasonable notice as the trustee determines 12 proper. They shall organize by the election of a president and 14 clerk, adopt a corporate seal and, when necessary, may choose a treasurer and all other needful officers and agents for the proper conduct and management of the affairs of the district. 16 They may also ordain and establish bylaws as are necessary for 18 their own convenience and the proper management of the affairs of the district. The trustees of said district holding office at the effective date of the act continue to hold office until the 20 annual town meeting of the inhabitants of the Town of Hampden 22 next following the expiration of the current term of office of each trustee. 24 At the annual town meeting of the inhabitants of the Town of 26 Hampden to be held in the year 1970, and at each annual town meeting after that date, the inhabitants shall choose the 28 trustees of the district for a term of 5 years. The trustees must be nominated and elected under the same procedure as provided for the town councilors of the town. 30 32 The term of office of the trustees begins on the 3rd Thursday of January. In the event a vacancy arises in the membership of the board of trustees, the unexpired term of the vacant office must 34 be filled by the Town Council of the Town of Hampden. When any 36 trustee ceases to be a resident of the district, the trustee shall vacate the office of trustee and the vacancy must be filled pursuant to this section. All trustees are eligible for 38 reelection, but a person holding the office of town councilor or 40 road commissioner in the Town of Hampden is not eligible for nomination or election as trustee. The trustees may procure an 42 office and incur expenses as may be necessary. The compensation of the trustees and the treasurer of the board of trustees is 44 determined by the board of trustees. At the close of each fiscal year, the trustees shall make a detailed report of their doings, 46 of the receipts and expenditures of the water district, of its financial and physical condition and of any other matters and things pertaining to the district that will show the inhabitants 48 of the district how the trustees are fulfilling the duties and obligations of their trust, such report to be made and filed with the Town Council of the Town of Hampden.

Sec. 3. P&SL 1937, c. 34, §10, as enacted, is amended to read:

Sec. 10. Contracts for supplying water. Said The water district 6 is hereby authorized to make contracts with the town Town of Hampden and with corporations and inhabitants of said the 8 district, for the purpose of supplying water as contemplated by this act, and the town Town of Hampden by its selectmen town 10 councilors is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with 12 said the district for a supply of water for public uses on such terms and for such time as the parties may agree, which contract 14 when made shall-be is legal and binding on all parties therete to the contract and said-town the Town of Hampden for said purposes may raise money in the same manner as for other municipal charges. 16

Sec. 4. P&SL 1937, c. 34, §14, as enacted, is amended to read:

Sec. 14. Qualified voters. In all elections hereunder under this act the selectmen town councilors of the town Town of
Hampden shall exclude from their lists and from all check lists the legal voters who are resident outside the territorial limits
of said the water district as defined in this act, and all warrant issued for elections shall must be varied accordingly to
show that only the voters resident within the territorial limits of said the water district are entitled to vote hereunder.

SUMMARY

32 This bill amends the terms of the trustees of the Hampden Water District and indicates that compensation for the trustees 34 and the treasurer of the board of trustees will be determined by the board of trustees.
