## SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the original resolution by amending the statutes governing the circulation of petitions that directly initiate legislation. This amendment requires that petitions circulated to directly initiate legislation include signatures from 10 of the State's 16 counties. The number of petition signatures collected in those counties muct equal 5% of the vote for Governor cast in that county in the last gubernatorial election preceding the filing of that petition.
