2 **Sec. 1. Reimbursement of State's share of salt and sand storage**
3 **facilities construction costs. Resolved:** That, notwithstanding the
4 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, section 1851 requiring
5 reimbursements to be made based on a schedule established by the
6 Department of Environmental Protection, the State shall
7 reimburse, in accordance with Title 23, chapter 13, subchapter
8 VII, those municipalities that have constructed, prior to January
9 1, 2001, salt and sand storage facilities that were approved by
10 the Department of Transportation. Reimbursement must be made no
11 later than December 31, 2001.

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SUMMARY

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15 This resolve requires the State to reimburse to
16 municipalities, by December 31, 2001, the State's share of the
17 costs of salt and sand storage facilities that were constructed
18 by municipalities and approved by the Department of
Transportation prior to January 1, 2001.
