COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 152, L.D. 163, Bill, "An Act to Extend Workers' Compensation Twenty-four-hour Pilot Projects"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble and emergency clause.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Bureau of Insurance within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation will incur some minor additional costs to review, monitor and evaluate any approved 24-hour plan. These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the committee. It removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
