'Sec. 1. Increase in reimbursement for therapy services. Resolved:
That the Department of Human Services shall adopt rules to increase the amount of reimbursement under the Medicaid program
for occupational and physical therapy and speech and language pathologist and audiologist services to 60% of the usual and customary charge applicable to that provider and service as of January 1, 2001, as determined by the Department of Human
Services. The department shall adopt these rules to take effect January 1, 2002; and be it further

Sec. 2. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

As amended, this bill also includes Federal Expenditures
 Fund allocations of \$123,157 and \$254,010 in fiscal years 2001-02
 and 2002-03, respectively, for the federal match.

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## **SUMMARY**

This amendment requires the Department of Human Services to adopt rules that take effect on January 1, 2002 to increase the amount of reimbursement under the Medicaid program for occupational and physical therapy and speech and language pathologist and audiologist services to 60% of the usual and 18 customary charge.
