2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2003, sub-§17** is enacted to read:

6 17. Exemption for concealed firearms permit holders from  
8 other states. A resident of another state who has a concealed  
10 firearms permit or has the legal right to carry a concealed  
12 firearm in another state may carry a concealed firearm in this  
14 State without meeting the requirements of this section.

16 **SUMMARY**

18 This bill allows persons who are allowed to carry concealed  
20 firearms in other states to carry concealed firearms in this  
22 State without having to get a permit to do so.
